



Kampagne #IdentifyMe Unknown dead women in the bog area “Worringer Bruch” in Cologne

CRIME: MURDER

FACTS OF THE CASE:

Cologne public prosecutor's office and Cologne criminal investigation department request your assistance!

On 14/10/2001, a mushroom picker found the almost completely skeletonised body of a woman in the bog area 'Worringer Bruch' on the outskirts of Cologne. She had been lying there between four months and a year. To date, the woman has not been identified.

REWARD:

For any information leading to the location/identification and apprehension of the person/s who committed the crime or identification of the victim, Cologne public prosecutor's office has offered a reward of EUR 5,000.

Only private individuals are entitled to the reward. Officers whose professional duties involve the investigation and prosecution of criminal acts are not entitled to it.

The reward will be granted and distributed without recourse to legal action according to the significance and relevance of the respective information received.

PERSONAL DETAILS

- Age: approximately 20 - 30 years

- short, strongly frizzy black hair
- remarkably healthy teeth



- hairpiece made of real hair, up to 10 cm long

CLOTHING:

- aubergine coloured quilted jacket
- black polo-neck jumper
- light blue jeans
- black women's shoes with a silver metal buckle

Near the place of discovery, a silver coloured bracelet with petrol coloured stones was found, too.

A conclusive cause of death has not been established which is why a crime cannot be ruled out.
