BASIC FACTS



- -ESTABLISHED UPON COUNCIL REGULATION OF 26 OCTOBER 2004 [(EC) 2007/2004, OJ L 249/25 Nov 2004]
- SEAT IN WARSAW, COUNCIL DECISION OF 14 APRIL 2005 [(EC) 358/2005, OJ L 114/4 May 2005]
- SUPREME COMMAND AND CONTROL IS EXCERCISED BY THE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF 25 (VOTING) MEMBERS
 - "BORDER CHIEFS" OF MSs AND 2 / CION
 - UK AND IRELAND CAN PARTICIPATE, NO VOTING
 - NORWAY, ICELAND AND SWITZERLAND AS OBSERVERS
 - BULGARIA AND ROMANIA AS OBSERVERS
- OPERATIONAL ON 3 OCTOBER 2005
- STAFF CONSISTING OF 69 PERSONS (85/115 staff foreseen in 2007)
- BUDGET FOR 2006 15,7 m€ (22,2 m€ + 8,5 m€ in reserve foreseen in 2007)



COORDINATES OPERATIONAL BORDER SECURITY COOPERATION BETWEEN THE EU MEMBER STATES


- ASSISTS THE MSs IN TRAINING OF BORDER GUARDS









RAPID BORDER INTERVENTION TEAMS




FRONTEX JOINT SUPPORT TEAMS






