Right-wing extremism – a challenge for Europe as a whole

Abstract

Various aspects of right-wing extremist incidents, influencing Europe as a whole are analysed in this contribution. Destabilising effects of successful right-wing extremist activities and campaigns of violence in individual countries and regions are explained. Moreover, the mutual inspiration and dissemination of the transnational trends (including new sub-cultural phenomena in the rightwing extremist scene) as well as the propagandistic support and mutual financial and material help are described. The positions of individual regions serving as the logistic background and training areas for paramilitary activities are looked at, specifically focusing on Eastern Europe. Pan-European campaigns, structures and organisations are presented and forecasts on their prospects are given.
