Edwin W. Kruisbergen (Edwin) is researcher at the Research and Documentation Centre (WODC) of the Dutch Ministry of Security and Justice. His fields of research include organized crime and methods of criminal investigation. He coordinates the Organized Crime Monitor, an ongoing systematic analysis of police files on organized crime in the Netherlands. So far, 150 cases were analysed. In March 2013 the fourth report of the Organized Crime Monitor was published and sent to Parliament. Other recent publications cover topics such as, among other things, undercover policing (2011, 2012, 2013) and women and organized crime (2013).

Abstract

This presentation addresses the following question: what are the main activities of organized crime groups in the Netherlands and what role does ICT plays in these activities? Sources of information that will be used are the Dutch Organized Crime Monitor and some recent cases, among other things.
