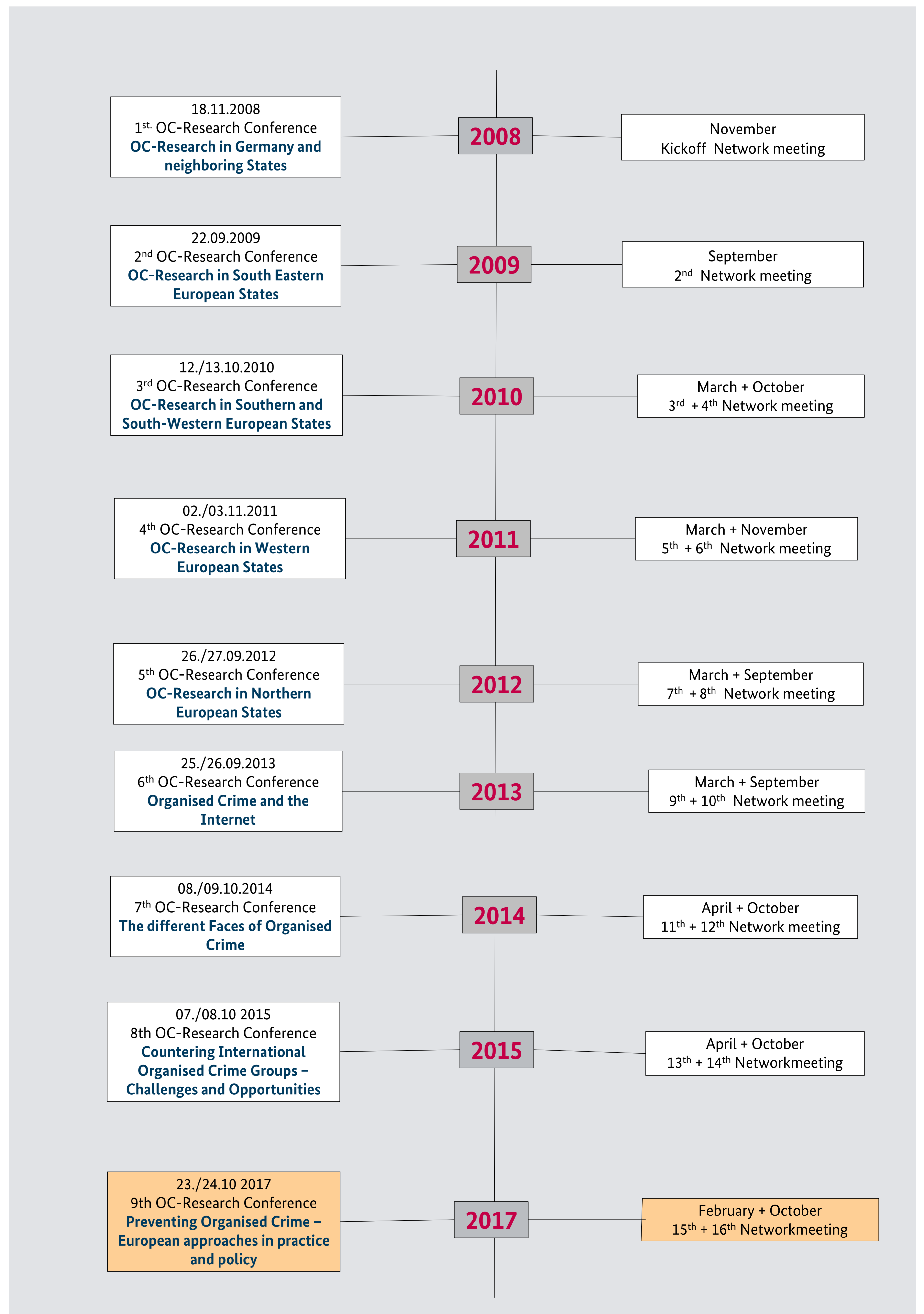

- The scope of the network is the scientific research on OC. Once or twice a year network meetings take place as well as an OC research conference annually.

History of the network

- The project "Research Network on Organised Crime" (March 2010 – February 2013) was within the scope of the Internal Security (ISEC) Programme "Prevention of and Fight against Crime".
- The follow-up project started in March 2010 and ended in February 2016.
- The current project "Research Network on Organised Crime 2017 – 2019" is within the scope of the Internal Security Fund (ISF).
